B.A. EDUCATION (HONS.) & M.A (EDUCATION) ADMISSION FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2026-27

Delhi Teachers University, a State University established by the Government of NCT of Delhi requests applicants seeking admission to the Under Graduate & Post Graduate programmes for the Academic year 2026-27. The admission process has started for Academic Year 2026-27 for Under Graduate & Post Graduate programme. The Delhi Teachers University has joined the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) to be conducted by NTA. In this regard, the National Testing Agency has been entrusted with the responsibility of conducting the Under Graduate & Post Graduate programmes entrance tests for the academic session 2026-27.

Relaxation of 5 % marks for SC/ ST/ PWBD/ Delhi OBC (NCL)/ Defence (Kashmiri Migrant).	Candidate must have appeared in CUET PG-2026 in one of the paper codes: - COQP16 or COQP15 or HUQP20 or HUQP22 or HUQP21.

ADMISSION PROCESS: Admission will be based on the score obtained in the CUET- UG & PG 2026 conducted by NTA. Applicants are required to fill the online 'Application Form', the link for the form will be available on the university website **detu.delhi.gov.in**

RESERVATION POLICY: Admissions will be made in accordance with the reservation policies of the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (GNCTD) in respect of various social groups and other categories as applicable to institutions of higher education. Applicants claiming the benefit of reservations will have to produce the requisite certificates from the competent authorities. The current scheme of reservations is given below:

S.No.	STUDENTS FROM	RESERVATION/ PERCENTAGE
01.	National Capital Territory of Delhi - 85%	D-OBC (NCL) -27%, DSC-15%, DST-7.5%
02.	Outside National Capital Territory of Delhi - 15%	ODSC-15%, ODST-7.5%

Note 1. Those who are appearing/ appeared for their final examinations and results are yet to be declared such candidates are also eligible to apply for the programme. However, they have to submit the proof of their result to fulfil the minimum eligibility for admission to the programme and to ascertain merit as per cut off obtained through CUET- UG & PG 2026 on the notified day of admission. In case of non-submission of the result/ non production of detailed mark sheet or relevant proof etc. from the respective Board/University on the notified day of verification of Certificates, as per cut off merit etc. notified, such candidates shall not be considered for admission.

Note 2. A Special Drive cum Spot Round shall be conducted only for filling up vacant seats in UG & PG Programme in case of withdrawal if any, where seats are vacant after exhausting the list of candidates in respective categories/region during the provisional admission list. The position of vacant seats is as on date and subject to change in case of withdrawals. CUET UG and PG score 2026 will remain the mandatory criteria along with fulfilling the eligibility as mentioned in Admission Brochure 2026-27.

Note 3. In case, seats still remain vacant after exhausting the list of applicants in respective programmes/region wise in Special Drive cum SPOT round, the vacant seats shall be filled from Non-CUET candidates. The eligibility will be as mentioned in admission brochure 2026-27. Interested applicants may also apply separately on the Non-CUET admission portal whose candidature shall be considered only, if seats remain vacant in Special Drive cum SPOT round. However, priority shall be given to CUET – UG & PG 2026 qualified candidates.

Note 4. If two or more candidate have the same CUET – UG or PG 2026 merit score, the marks of the last qualifying Senior Secondary for UG programme and UG degree will be counted as a tie breaker. If the score is still tied, the older in age applicant will be given admission.
