Delhi Teachers University, a State University established by the Government of NCT of Delhi requests applicants seeking admission to the Post Graduate programme for the Academic year 2025. The admission process has started for Academic Year 2025-26 for Post Graduate programme. The Delhi Teachers University has joined the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) to be conducted by NTA. In this regard, the National Testing Agency has been entrusted with the responsibility of conducting the Post Graduate entrance tests for the academic session 2025.

ADMISSION PROCESS

Admission will be based on the score obtained in the CUET- PG 2025 conducted by NTA. Applicants are required to fill the online 'Application Form', the link for the form will be available on the university website www.delhiteachersuniversity.edu.in

RESERVATION POLICY

Admissions will be made in accordance with the reservation policies of the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (GNCTD) in respect of various social groups and other categories as applicable to institutions of higher education. Applicants claiming the benefit of reservations will have to produce the requisite certificates from the competent authorities. The current scheme of reservations is given below:

Note 1. Those who are appearing/ appeared for their final examinations and results are yet to be declared such candidates are also eligible to apply for the programme. However, they have to submit the proof of their result to fulfil the minimum eligibility for admission to the programme and to ascertain merit as per cut off obtained through CUET-PG 2025 on the notified day of admission. In case of non-submission of the result/ non production of detailed mark sheet or relevant proof etc. from the respective Board/University on the notified day of verification of Certificates, as per cut off merit etc. notified, such candidates shall not be considered for admission.

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Note 2. A **Special Drive cum Spot Round** shall be conducted only for filling up vacant seats in PG Programme in case of withdrawal if any, where seats are vacant after exhausting the list of candidates in respective categories/region during the provisional admission list. The position of vacant seats is as on date and subject to change in case of withdrawals. CUET (PG) score 2025 will remain the mandatory criteria along with fulfilling the eligibility as mentioned in Admission Brochure 2025-26.

Note 3. In case, seats still remain vacant after exhausting the list of applicants in respective programmes/region wise in Special Drive cum SPOT round, the vacant seats shall be filled from Non-CUET candidates. The eligibility will be as mentioned in admission brochure 2025-26. Interested applicants may also apply separately on the Non-CUET admission portal whose candidature shall be considered only, if seats remain vacant in Special Drive cum SPOT round. However, priority shall be given to CUET - PG 2025 qualified candidates.

Note 4. If two or more candidate have the same CUET – PG 2025 merit score, the marks of the last qualifying UG degree will be counted as a tie breaker. If the score is still tied, the older in age applicant will be given admission.
